Submission Guidelines

We invite a variety of submission types and are interested in research across all four streams of the project. We hope the presentations will provide insight into current findings and avenues of exploration and begin to address the key questions this research set out to explore. Papers do not need to present complete findings and can be viewed as a pathway to further development and journal publication.

Professor Andrew Beer will write an Introduction to the day, and after the workshop has been completed, we will publish the presentations online.
